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8. Processing of personal data

Through your application, Stockholm University will collect information about your name, date of birth, nationality, gender, telephone number, transcript of records and email address to be able to process your application.

The processing is done as part of our exercise of official authority as a university in order to assess and take a decision on your application. The data will be saved for as long as needed for the handling of your exchange and will be anonymized in this system after your academic exchange year.

Your name, date of birth, address, email address, course registrations and study results will be stored in the national student registrar Ladok.

We will also collect your emergency contact details, which will be saved during your stay abroad and then deleted.

For Erasmus students the application form (with attachments), transcript of records and learning agreement will be saved up to seven years according to the Erasmus programme requirement for documentation.

Your name, date of birth, transcript of records and email address will be passed to individual departments (if you choose courses offered by other departments) and within Student Services at Stockholm University for the purposes of university registration and course registration.

Your name, home university, main field of study and email address will also be passed on to international coordinators at the other departments at Stockholm University involved in teacher education/pedagogical sciences. This is done for the purpose to invite you to joint welcome activities during the exchange semester. Your name and email will be deleted from this list after the exchange semester.

You may demand to see what is registered about you by contacting the International Office. Complaints that cannot be resolved with Stockholm University may be submitted to <u>The Swedish Data Protection Authority (DPA)</u>.
